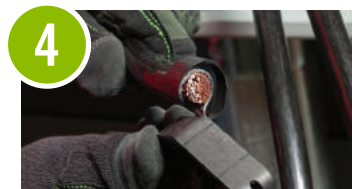
1 Set blade depth by rotating knob to jacket thickness

3 Clockwise rotation executes spiral cut to end of cable



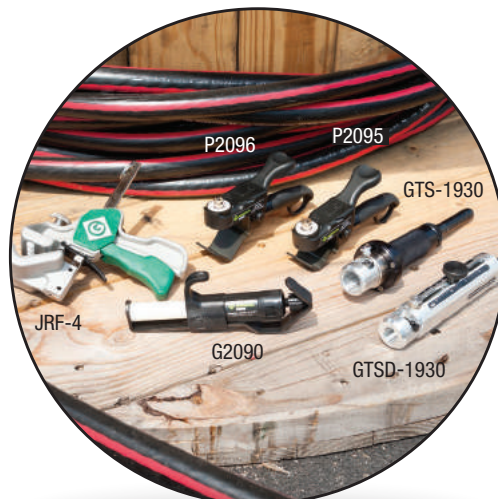
4 Lifting edge allows for easy removal of cable jacket
